
## Palestine- British mandate


- Palestinian Arabs 90% of Population




#### The 1948 War

- Independence of the State of Israel declared
- The NEXT DAY Arab troops from Jordan, Iraq, Syria, Lebanon, Egypt And Saudi Arabia invaded Palestine
- By end of 1948 Israel captured most of the land
- Creation of over 700,000 Palestinian refugees




### **The Suez Canal Crisis**

- 1956 Egyptian leader
  Gamal Abdel Nasser tried
  to take control of Suez
  Canal
- Britain and France were mad and Israel decided to join them to force Nasser to give it back.



#### The 1967 War

- Nasser continued to cause trouble
- Israel had also suffered increasing terrorist attacks by Palestinian groups in Syrian and Jordanian territories
- Israel felt itself surrounded by hostile forces
- 1967 launched surprise attack and capturing Gaza, Sinai, Golan Heights and West Bank
